Upgrading an existing setup to V1.0.118 -

- 1. Install Rapidose 1.0.118.
 - Remove the existing Rapidose version via Windows Add/Remove programs. Note: this process will not disturb existing Rapidose data or license files.
 - b. Shut down and re-boot to be sure Windows has forgotten all old Rapidose versions.
 - c. Open the Rapidose 1.0.118 install folder and double click on Setup. Respond yes to windows questions. The
 - d. Once installed, launch Rapidose and verify the installation by clicking on



the "I" icon. Look to be sure the Rapidose version is 1.0.118.

Installing Rapidose On Your Computer

1. Insert the Rapidose flash drive into an available USB port, and allow the operating system to recognize the device. Choose 'Open folder to view files using Windows Explorer'.
